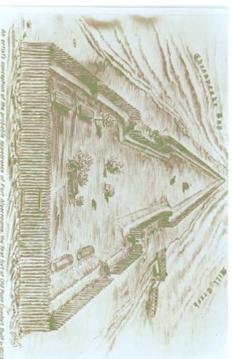

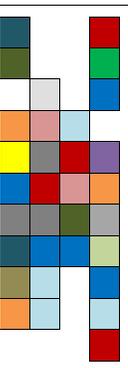


To determine your next stop, subtract 1730 from the year the first concrete seawall was built and fill in the blanks

5. Fort Monroe was a functioning U.S. Army base until recently, there are a number of Bunkers, Batteries, and other Buildings that may contain hazardous materials, including asbestos. They may look interesting to explore, please don't, unless it specifies visitors welcomed.
