A national monument, Fort Monroe is the largest stone fortification ever built in the U.S. During the Civil War, Union-held Fort Monroe sheltered thousands of enslaved people seeking freedom. Within the fort's walls, the Casemate Museum chronicles the history of Fort Monroe, the Coast Artillery Corps and Old Point Comfort. Visitors can stand in the cell where Confederate President Jefferson Davis was imprisoned. FREE
